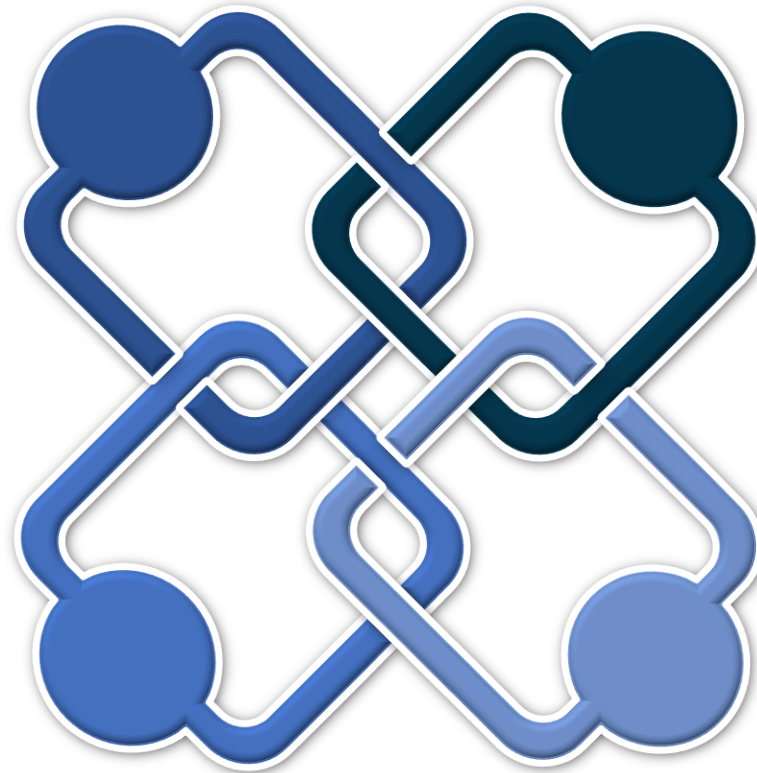
INTRODUCTION

WG on Development of OIC-StatCom SV

- Was established in 2018
- Composed of 2 Co-Chairs & 22 members

Questionnaire

- Circulated in July 2019 to all NSOs
- As of 29 Nov 2019, 39 OIC countries submitted their responses (69% response rate)



OIC-StatCom SV

- Prepared based on the survey responses & feedback received during the 8th Session of OIC-StatCom
- Reference document for PoAs for 2021-2025 & 2026-2030
- Resolution item #4 of the 8th Session of OIC-StatCom
- Final version of the document was shared with the NSOs of OIC countries on 8 July 2020

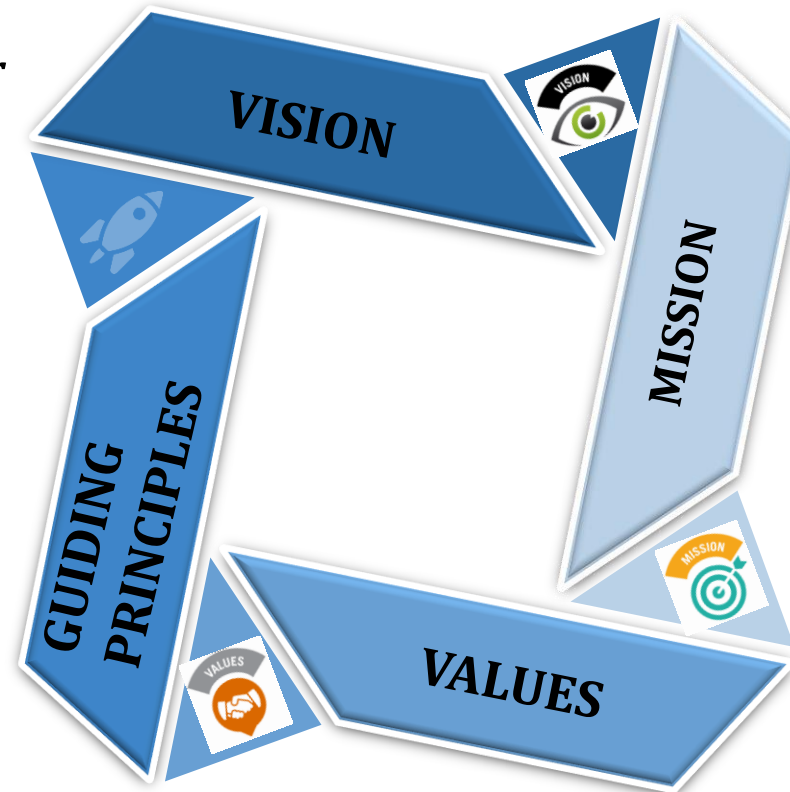

- **Objective 1.1.** Strengthen the coordination role of NSOs within the NSSs.
- **Objective 1.2.** Advance the cooperation and collaboration among OIC-StatCom and other national, regional, and international stakeholders active in the production of data and statistics.

SA 2. Statistical Capacity Development

- **Objective 2.1.** Ensure that statistical needs and capacities of NSSs of OIC member countries are identified based on the international frameworks.
- **Objective 2.2.** Implement statistical capacity development activities based on the OIC-level and global development agenda.

SA 3. Statistical Modernisation and Innovation

- **Objective 3.1.** Modernise governance and institutional frameworks to allow NSSs to meet the demands and opportunities of constantly evolving data ecosystems.

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 1.1. Strengthen the coordination role of NSOs within the NSSs.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Integrate the necessary processes related to the collection, collation, production, and dissemination of sustainable development data into their ongoing and planned NSDS, official statistics work programmes, and where possible, national and sectoral development strategies and priorities. ***(continuous)***
- Strengthen coordination between their institutions and other constituents of their NSSs through – including but not limited to – national statistical councils or similar platforms. ***(continuous)***

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Organise a Workshop / Forum related to Coordination within NSSs. ***(2021)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 1.2. Advance the cooperation and collaboration among OIC-StatCom and other national, regional, and international stakeholders active in the production of data and statistics.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Improve their linkages of cooperation and collaboration with other constituents of their NSSs, regional and international statistical stakeholders. *(continuous)*
- Organise/participate in the OIC-level and international meetings/workshops related to statistics to exchange knowledge and their country experiences. *(continuous)*

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Organise the Annual Sessions and Follow-Up Meetings of OIC-StatCom to advance the cooperation and collaboration among the OIC-StatCom members. *(continuous)*
- Enact new MoUs or renew the previously signed MoUs. *(continuous)*

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 2.1. Ensure that statistical needs and capacities of NSSs of OIC member countries are identified based on the international frameworks.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Respond timely and fully to the survey circulated biennially. ***(continuous)***
- Encourage their official statisticians to register their profiles on the Roster of Statistics Experts (ROSE). ***(continuous)***

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Conduct a survey biennially to identify the statistical needs and capacities of the OIC-StatCom members. ***(2021, 2023, 2025)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 2.2. Implement statistical capacity development activities based on the OIC-level and global development agenda.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Allocate sufficient resources to the capacity development of their human resources. ***(continuous)***
- Implement and contribute to the StatCaB Programme activities. ***(continuous)***
- Share their statistical training curricula, if any, with the OIC-StatCom Secretariat to be made accessible online. ***(continuous)***

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Match the statistical needs and capacities of the OIC-StatCom members. ***(continuous)***
- Facilitate the conduct of the planned StatCaB activities within the limits of the resources made available to the Secretariat. ***(continuous)***
- Engage, where possible, with other relevant regional and international organisations to co-organise statistical capacity building activities. ***(continuous)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 3.1. Modernise governance and institutional frameworks to allow NSSs to meet the demands and opportunities of constantly evolving data ecosystems.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Advocate at appropriate levels for the development / revision of their national statistics laws and regulatory frameworks. *(continuous)*
- Integrate open data principles, as much as possible, into their processes and ensure that the constituents of their NSSs accordingly follow their lead. *(continuous)*

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Organise a Workshop related to Modernising Statistical Legislation. *(2022)*

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 3.2. Facilitate the application of new statistical architectural frameworks to improve statistical production and dissemination processes.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Apply the range of standards needed for statistical modernization. ***(continuous)***

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Organise a Workshop related to Generic Models of Statistical Production and Architecture. ***(2023)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 4.1. Promote harmonisation of concepts, classifications and methodologies used in performing statistical activities in OIC member countries to promote consistency in statistical systems.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Unify the statistical concepts, classifications, and methodologies used in their NSSs to be compatible with the internationally accepted statistical standards and norms. ***(continuous)***
- Develop a one-stop online repository to host the relevant internationally accepted statistical standards and norms. ***(continuous)***
- Ensure country ownership of internationally sponsored socio-economic survey programmes towards producing and disseminating internationally comparable data. ***(continuous)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 4.2. Strive to produce common methodologies for selected statistical indicators specific to OIC member countries.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Encourage the relevant constituents of their NSSs to adopt the Prudential and Structural Islamic Financial Indicators (PSIFIs) methodology. ***(continuous)***
- Develop national methodologies, in close collaboration with the relevant stakeholders for the collection, collation, processing, and dissemination of Muslim Friendly Tourism data. ***(continuous)***

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Identify needs and capacities of OIC member countries concerning the production and dissemination of Muslim Friendly Tourism indicators. ***(2021, 2023, 2025)***
- Organise an Expert Group Meeting related to the Development of Muslim Friendly Tourism indicators. ***(2024)***

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 5.1. Improve the production of high-quality, accessible, timely, reliable and disaggregated data by all characteristics relevant in national contexts in line with OIC-level and international development agenda.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Develop/update their National Quality Assurance Frameworks (NQAFs) in collaboration with the constituents of their NSSs, where possible, by considering the United Nations NQAFs Manual for Official Statistics, its Self-Assessment Checklist, and emerging data sources for sustainable development. *(continuous)*

KEY ACTIONS FOR 2021-2025 & ITS YEARS OF IMPLEMENTATION

SO 5.2. Increase the competencies of OIC member countries in the use of administrative registries towards high-quality statistics instrumental in the monitoring of OIC-level and international development agenda.

OIC-STATCOM MEMBERS

- Advocate at the decision-making level towards the modification of their regulatory frameworks for the use of registries and administrative data. *(continuous)*
- Develop the necessary methodologies, infrastructure, and statistical/other relevant skills for better access to the administrative registries. *(continuous)*

OIC-STATCOM SECRETARIAT

- Organise a Workshop related to the Use of Administrative Registers as Data Sources for Monitoring the OIC-Level and International Development Agenda. *(2025)*
